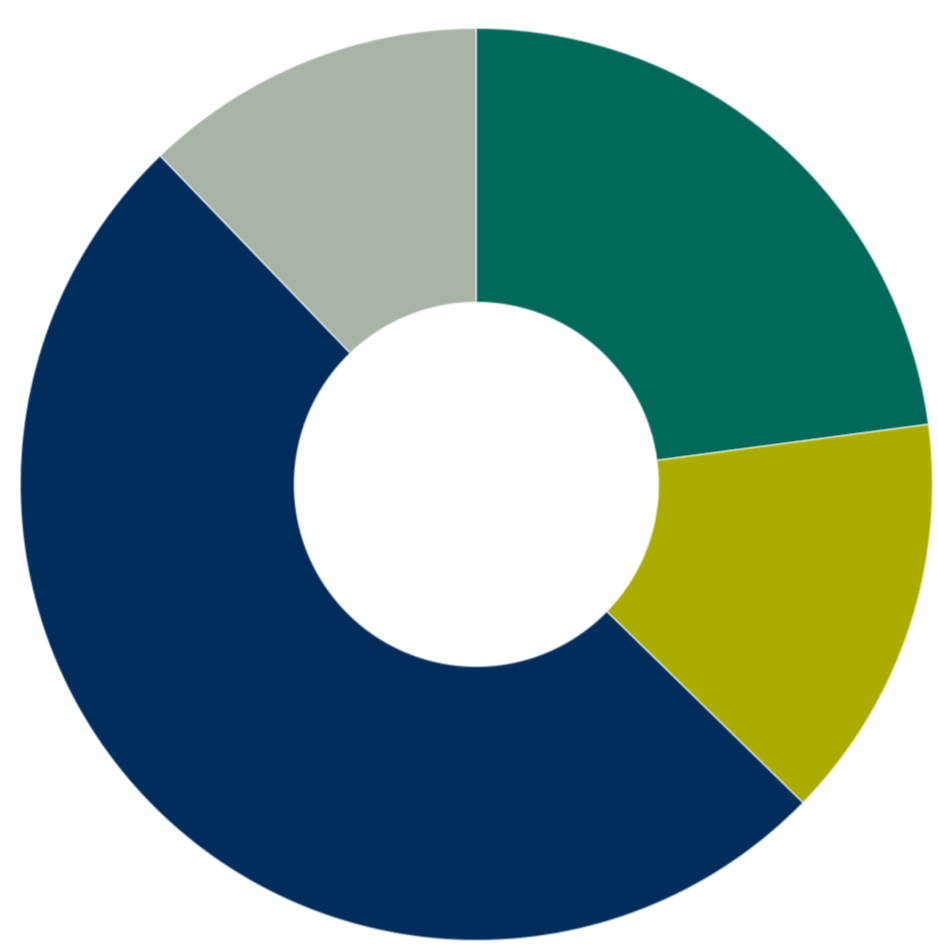

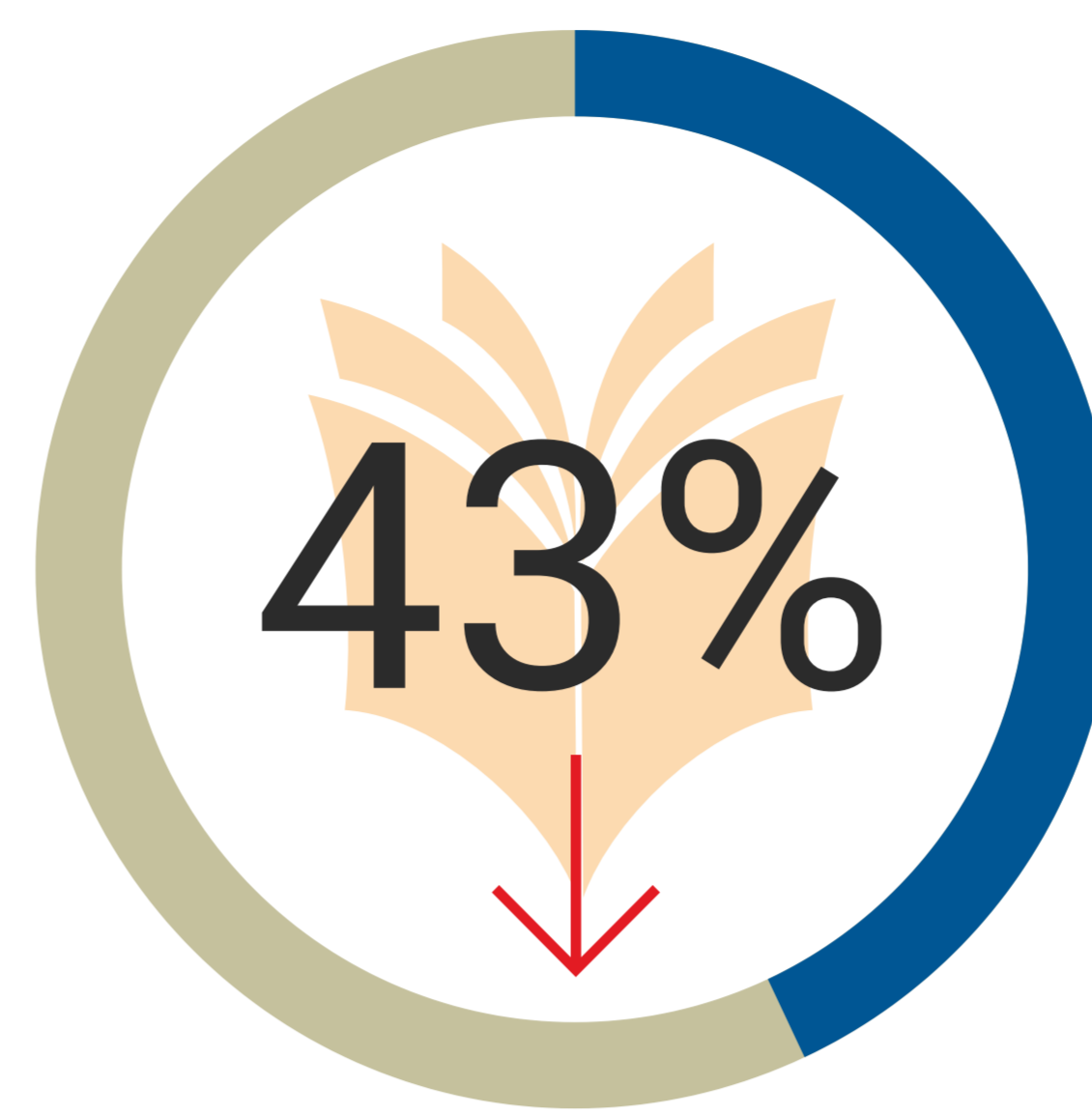

Percentage of students scoring at or above Proficient

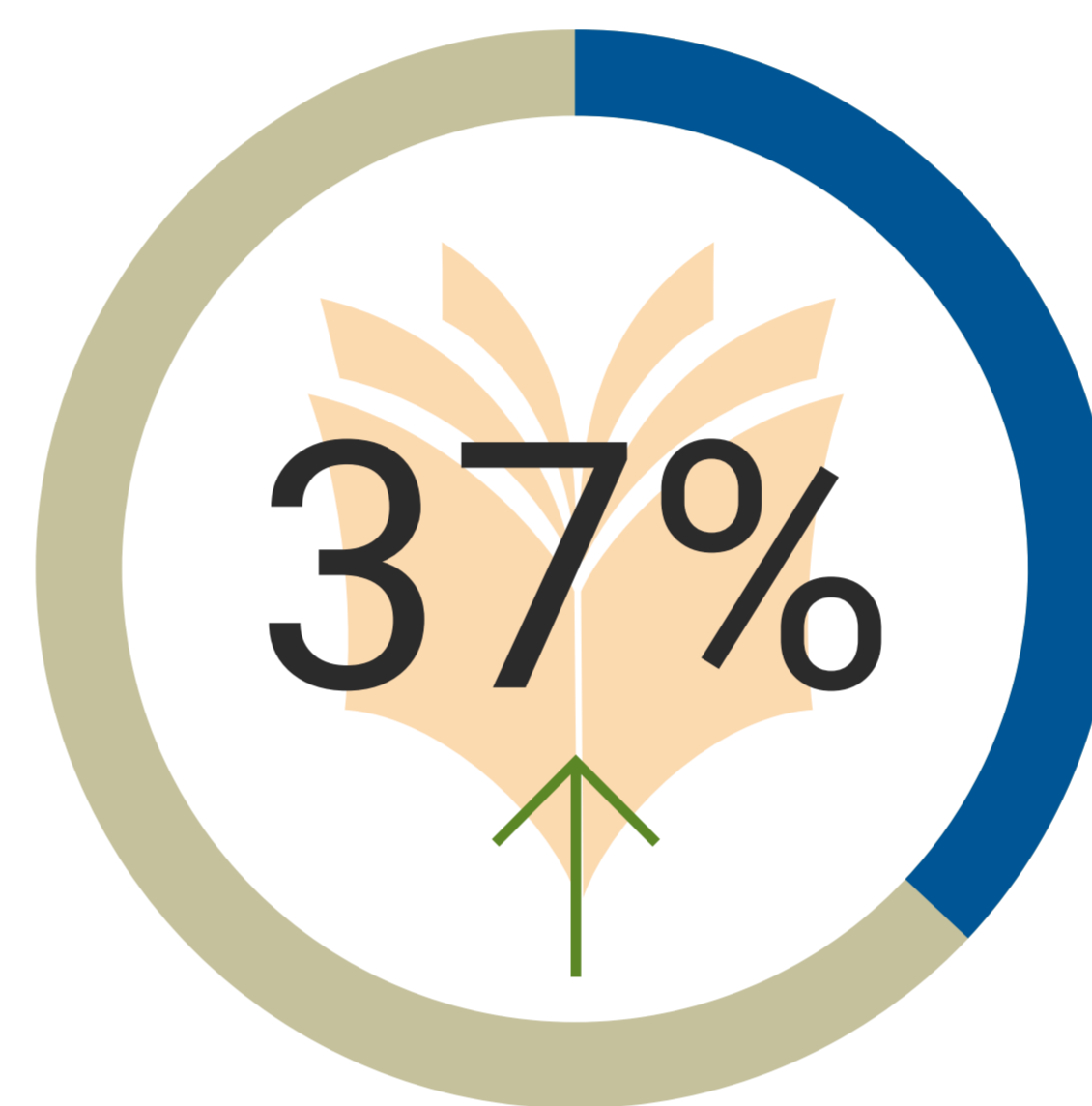

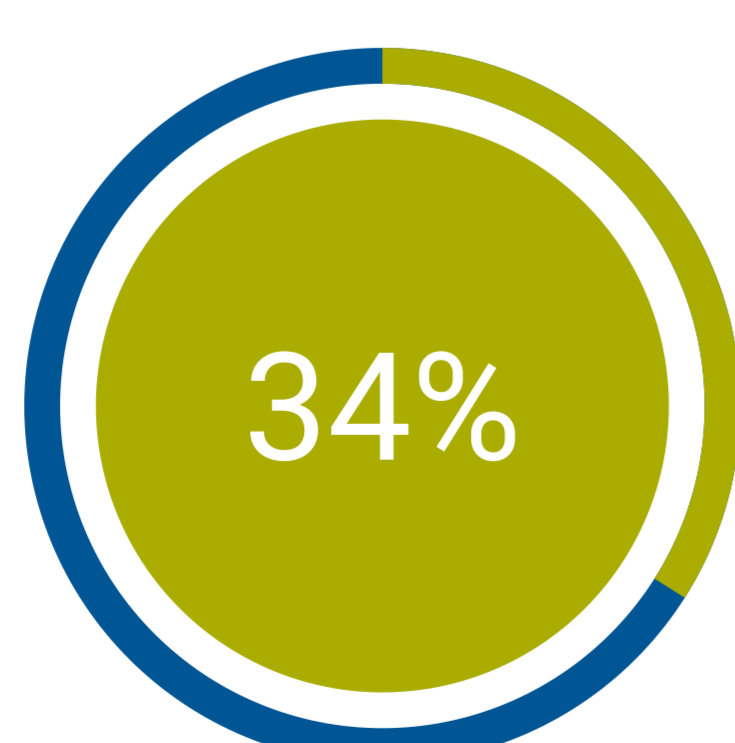
